

M-Pak Machine Condition Guidelines

As-Is: "AS-IS" items are sold as they are described without any warranty. Unless otherwise indicated, items listed in our online used machinery inventory should be considered "as-is" items. No particular effort has been made to improve the condition of the machine. These machines may not have been tested.

Reconditioned: Reconditioned equipment has undergone a general cleaning and lubrication. Any excessive corrosion is removed. Components are visually inspected and may be re-used if they are within specified operating tolerance. Items normally considered to be expendable part items are replaced. Missing parts essential to the operation of the machine are replaced to make the machine operational. Machine is tested to insure that it is operational but no extensive production test is performed. May come with warranty.

Rebuilt: Rebuilt equipment is usually disassembled. Components are inspected and may be re-used if they are within specified operating tolerance. All worn parts (parts that are out of operating tolerance) and missing parts are replaced. Anything that is within "wear limits" is not necessarily replaced. Parts that routinely wear out, usually the brushes, bushings, etc., are replaced. Machine is cleaned and lubricated. May be repainted depending on cosmetic condition of the machine. Machine is fully tested to insure operational reliability. Generally comes with a warranty.

Remanufactured: This is the closest thing to new. Remanufactured items are completely disassembled, cleaned/lubricated, and inspected before being reassembled. All components are inspected and may be re-used if they are within new tolerances (new tolerance is a tougher standard than operating tolerance). Each part is checked to see that it meets standards for a new device. So everything that is worn is replaced. Generally comes with new wiring and paint. Machine is fully tested to insure like-new operation in production condition. Generally comes with an owners manual and a warranty that is same as new.
